Subject: Safe Haven Products

Mrs. Baker:

I have reviewed several projects where Safe Haven Products have been utilized and I wanted to write you to state for the record my opinion of the quality and relative safety of Safe Haven Products.

Based on my engineering evaluation of the Safe Haven Blast Resistant Modules the building design is very robust. The major framing members and crimped panels are all made from ½" thick plate which, to my knowledge, is the thickest material used in the BRM market and far thicker that most manufacturers I am aware of. The amount, size and quality of the welded connections are excellent. These two items alone are enough to convince me that Safe Haven produces BRMs that are among the safest on the market but there are other features that add to their safety and quality.

The Blast Resistant Doors that Safe Haven manufactures are equally robust in design and materials of construction. In one instance I am personally aware of, one of your buildings sustained a blast in excess of 10 psi. The building showed little ill effect and in fact the only notable damage was a bent door latch however the door remained closed and could still be opened.

Additionally, the buildings are surprisingly energy efficient and quiet due in no small part to the coatings and insulations utilized on your buildings.

Finally, I have reviewed the testing you have performed to prove your BRMs, doors and windows and so I can say without reservation that your products are very safe and are my preferred selection for BRMs, Blast Resistant Doors and Windows.
